

## Gentian helps fund new sports equipment for The Westgate School (20 November 2024)

Winchester-based property developer Gentian aims to positively impact the communities where it operates and as a commitment to this, they have donated £5,000 locally to The Westgate School to provide much-needed new sports equipment.

The Westgate School have used the funds towards four new sets of goal posts and footballs and four new basketball hoops and basketballs.
