

Sustainability first: pre-loved uniform shop opens at The Westgate School, Winchester

After operating out of cupboards and living rooms for years, a group of parent volunteers at the Westgate School, Winchester, is now opening a second-hand uniform shop on the school site. Its official opening will take place at The PSA Christmas Fair at 11am on Saturday 7th December, opened by our local MP, Dr Danny Chambers.

The PSA uniform team has collected and sold preloved uniform across The Westgate School's primary and secondary phases for around five years. As awareness of this service grows and with the increased focus on Slow Fashion, the PSA worked with the school to identify a shop location and a permanent base for the uniform stock.

"Children grow fast and as parents it can feel like we're buying larger sizes every term and clearing out our outgrown uniform to make space. Many of the donations we receive are in great condition and parents are very happy to be able to reduce textile waste and buy uniform at a reduced price. It's good for the planet, good for parents, and good for the whole school community as money raised is put back into the school through the PSA," says Jo Gibson, PSA uniform lead.

The PSA uniform team, made up of parent volunteers, is dedicated to making second-hand uniform accessible to families through both online and table-top sales. It also provides uniform free of charge to those most in need, such as refugees and those suffering financial hardship.

The Westgate School Parent & Staff Association raises funds to support pupil learning and wellbeing across both Primary and Secondary phases, and its recent fundraising activity has provided funding for a 3D printer, playground equipment, musical instruments, and author visits.
